West Michigan Food Processing Association (WMFPA) was created to connect West Michigan's food processing industry from farm to table and link farmers, food processors, government, and economic development officials with resources, infrastructure, new markets, and educational institutions to train the current and future workforce.

To continue this work, WMFPA created the West Michigan Food Processing Association Fund to support food and agriculture initiatives that inspire innovative regional collaboration and solutions that are focused on food and food processing-related economic development and expansion, sustainable environmental practices and innovations in food processing, and efforts to enhance social impact to aid area farmers, students, nonprofits, and food-related businesses in Newaygo County and the surrounding area.

Examples of successful initiatives can include:

- Programming that will benefit area farmers, students, or food businesses
- Regional convenings that include stakeholders in the food and agriculture regional supply chain

Grants made from this fund will support local agriculture. Fund representatives will meet with the Community Foundation to make decisions on annual grant awards.
